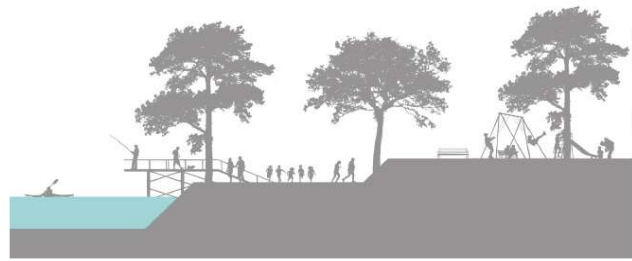

Board Report

Meeting—The BRC met on Wednesday, April 1, 2026, at 9:00am

Storage Shed—George Lohmann has built a shelf and installed hooks for equipment in the shed.

Basketball/Pickleball Court—Rob Howland and Steve Rozelle installed the backboard and basketball hoop in late March, and on April 13, Bill Spoonhower's son graded the area around the basketball court area.. George contacted Ryan Hand of Hand Made Projects LLC to solicit a bid for painting the basketball and pickleball court lines using the paint received from an earlier grant. In discussion with Mike Simmons, option 2 was selected priced at \$1,800. \$1,250 will be covered by the rest of the Truman grant and the rest from funds collected from the ballpark banner advertisers. 10%, i., e., \$180, is required to schedule the work.
